CBM's Proposed Caledon Quarry Introductory Meeting

Due to the rapidly developing situation in Ontario with coronavirus (COVID-19), and in the interest of public safety, <u>CBM has decided to postpone the</u> <u>public information session planned for March 25, 2020 in</u> <u>Alton, Ontario</u>.

This decision has been made based on guidance provided by the World Health Organization and the Public Health Agency of Canada regarding mass gatherings and public events. Project Background

CBM is exploring the feasibility of developing a quarry in the vicinity of Charleston Sideroad and Main Street/Regional Road 136 in the Town of Caledon. CBM initiated technical studies in February 2020 to assist in determining the feasibility of future extraction, and to support the required applications that may be filed for municipal and provincial approvals under the *Planning Act* and the *Aggregate Resources Act*. These technical studies will be completed over the next two years, and the Project is still at the very early stages.
